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Falcon Cues Ltd History

Falcon Cues Ltd was first established in the year 1991 by Mr. Ernie C., a Taiwanese-Canadian entrepreneur with the passion for the game of pool who immigrated to Toronto, Canada in the year 1990 with hopes for a better life for his family. Prior to this, he was a dedicated pool player and a successful businessman.

Before his move to Canada, he had realized the convenience of the location (Toronto) for easy access to some of the most beautiful timbers in the world, Canadian maple and also it's short distance to its powerful neighbor, the United States. Since he was young and just learning how to play pool, he had dreamed about owning a pool cue factory that would build only the best quality professional grade cues for the enthusiasts. He decided that Canada would be the place to realize his dream.



In the year 1991, during a rare opportunity, Ernie was able to meet with famed American cue manufacturer Joss Cues and they decided to enter into a business venture together. Therefore, the Falcon brand was established and the first manufacturing facility was set up in

Mississauga, a quiet little town about 30 minutes away from downtown Toronto. With the help from Joss Cues, Falcon quickly gained a good reputation amongst the professional player's circle and was able to attract some of the finest names to ever play the game. Such players include Jeanette Lee, Jennifer Chen, Nick Varner, Karen Korr, Shin Mai Liu and many other outstanding players across the globe.



In 1993, Falcon ended its venture with Joss Cues and teamed up with Mr. Alan McCarty of Clawson Cues (now known as Predator Cues), who envisioned a brand new concept for the future of pool cues but needed manufacturing support that he believed would change the game of pool for many years to come. After hearing his proposal, Ernie decided to provide manufacturing supports for Clawson Cues to help Mr. McCarty realize his dream and concept. For many years to follow, Falcon Cues Ltd was the proud manufacturer and business partner of Clawson Cues (Predator Cues), which helped Falcon Cues to further develop its cue making abilities and techniques that shaped them into the company that they are today.

Falcon Cues Ltd are now entering into their 24th year in business and continue to manufacture professional standard, high quality pool cues at affordable prices. They believe that all pool enthusiasts should have the chance to play with a quality pool cue.

Following the most traditional methods of hand craftsmanship, Falcon stainless steel joints are hand polished by our skilled technicians.

We also offer phenolic and wood joint cues depending on the series.

Forearm Materials

Falcon uses only the best forearm materials in the market today woods such as ebony, Canadian birdseye maple, curly maple, rosewood cocobolo, bacote, zebra, burl maples...etc are all woods that you expect to see on a Falcon cue.

Inlays

All inlays are designed from scratch and engraved with our CNC machine then hand fitted piece by piece. It is truly a work of art.

Wrap

All Falcon Cues use the best quality Irish linen from England. Each linen wrap is hand wrapped and pressed in house to ensure a quality and smooth feel.

We also offer leather wraps and sports wraps for those seeking to be unique.

Shaft

Falcon shafts use only the best quality Canadian maple from the region of Montreal, Quebec. All lumbars are purchased from the source and come kiln dried. Each shaft is then processed in our own kiln and then CNC turned to ensure the most precision in size.

Ferrule

Falcon uses only the best ferrule material from the USA, JUMA. These ferrules are more durable than our previous material.

Tips

This year, Falcon introduces its own custom made tips to be equipped on its standard line of cues. Our tips come in multi layered pig skin with Medium and Hard densities to choose from.

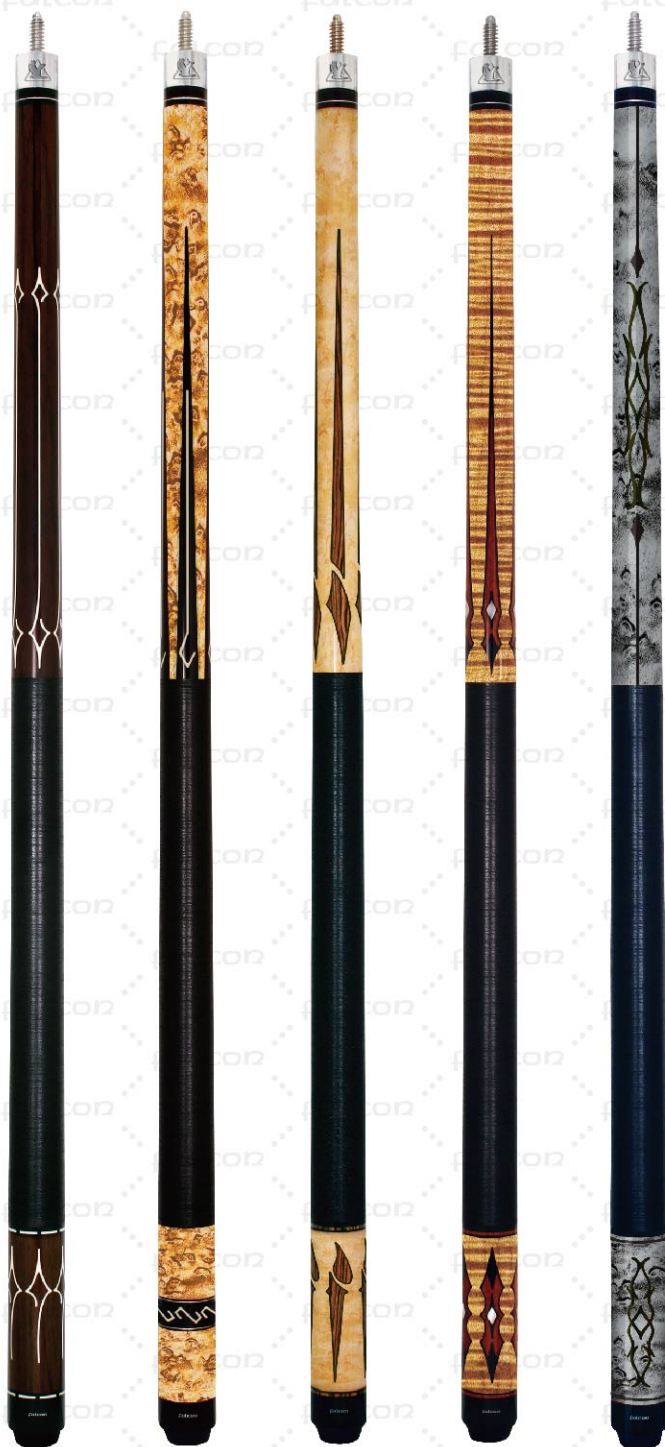

FALCON CONSUMER WARRANTY POLICY

STORAGE: Solid wood will absorb moisture in wet climates and release moisture in dry climates which causes the cue to warp or rings to pop up. To prevent warpage or finish problems, it is important to store your cue in places with consistent temperature and moisture conditions, ideally at room temperature inside a cue case. Avoid leaving your cues in the car.

USE: Cues made of wood are not designed to withstand side pressure. Situations where a cue is leaning against a wall, dropped on the floor, or hitting a table can damage the cue. If the cue is stored on a wall mounted rack, be sure it is kept upright.

TIP DIAMETER: We do not recommend turning your shaft but if you do, do not turn it below 12mm for pro taper shafts or 12.50mm for Euro taper shafts or your Limited Warranty will be voided.

SHAFT: To clean a Falcon Cues Ltd shaft, use only very fine micropapers for burnishing. To avoid damaging your new shaft, do not sand it! Do not expose the shaft to excessive moisture and do not steam to remove dings, or use damp cloth to wipe down the shaft. Use Isopropyl alcohol with soft towels to clean the shaft if absolutely necessary.

UNI-LOC/RADIAL PIN JOINT: We recommend cleaning the Uni-Loc or Radial Pin Joint when you first receive your cue and every six months thereafter. These joints are precision manufactured to exact tolerances and even a modest amount of dirt can create problems. We suggest using a Q-Tip dipped in Isopropyl Alcohol to clean the inside threads and bore of the insert in the shaft. Use a clean rag and alcohol to clean the joint pin and threads as well.

FERRULE: Much of the shaft's performance can be attributed to the type of ferrules we use therefore it is important to provide maintenance and inspection to the ferrule section from time to time. To remove scratches, use a very fine 1000 grit micro paper and exercise with care. The wood adjoining the ferrule is much softer than the ferrule itself and sanding the wood inadvertently could damage the shaft. Please note that if overheated, the ferrule will melt.

TIP: If tip replacement is required, we recommend a tip of medium hardness. Falcon Cues Ltd. cues come with various types of tips according to the different series. We currently offer our own Grade A leather, 5 layer leather and Triangle tips. For best results, we recommend that you have a professional cue maker or cue repair person perform the change on a lathe. Remember, the wood will sand away faster than the ferrule and if the ferrule is overheated, it will melt.

WRAP CLEANING: Use mild soap and water moderately (as little as possible) for leather wraps and Isopropyl alcohol for Genuine Irish Linen wraps.

USING THE RIGHT CUE: A player may encounter various shots in a single pool game which can be separated into three major types: break, jump and normal shots. Falcon Cues Ltd strongly advise our customers to choose the right cue for the right shot! This means, when performing a break shot, it is advised to use our TNT jump break or Charger break cues. Jump and break cues are designed to the specifications to make these types of shots and normal playing cues are not. Players who use playing cues to break/jump may damage the structure of the playing cue in the long run which shortens the life of the cue.

If you should ever experience a problem that you deem as our fault and should be covered under warranty, please contact your local Falcon dealers/distributors or e-mail us directly to peter@falconcues.com and a representative will review your case immediately. Please note that this warranty does not cover problems resulting from warping or user abuse/misuse.

1.) Terms and Conditions: Falcon Cues Ltd. warrants solely to the original purchaser of a particular Falcon Cues Ltd product/products that the product purchased shall be free from defects in materials and workmanship under normal use for as long as original purchaser has ownership. Damage resulting from: (a) normal wear and tear; (b) modification, misuse, abuse or improper maintenance; (c) accidents or exposure to extreme temperature, humidity or weather conditions which cause harm to the wood will not be covered under the limited warranty. This Limited Warranty applies only to those products purchased from authorized dealers of Falcon Cues Ltd.
